## How to Create Collections

Welcome to B.R.I.D.G.E. TO DATA<sup>®</sup>.

In this tutorial, we will focus on creating a database collection.

- Collections are specific to individual users and will help you narrow down your search results by • selecting database profiles to compare and save for the future.
- With collections, you will be able to compare multiple profiles across all your collections, side-byside.
- 1. To get started, login with your username and password on the home screen.
  - You may conduct a new search or use one of the saved searches you did earlier.
- diabetes 2. As an example, we will use the saved search from earlier for Diabetes.
- 3. To create a **new** collection, select [Create New] from the drop down, give it a name, and click [Save].
  - A confirmation will appear at the top of the page.
- 4. At the bottom of each profile, you will also have the option to add it to an existing collection. To do Add to database collection: so, select it from the drop-down list and click [Save].
  - A confirmation on the top of the page tells us it has been added.
  - Please note: Collections a profile is already included in, will not be listed as an option.
- 5. You may also use the select box above each profile to add up to three to an existing collection.

Now let's see what else we can do.

- 6. Clicking MY COLLECTIONS on the navigation bar will let you see all your collections.
  - Note that your collections cannot be shared with other users.

Now let us select some profiles to compare side-by-side.

-- Select Collectior V Save

- 7. Check the boxes of the profiles you wish to compare within a single collection or across multiple collections.
- 8. Click **Compare** if they are within a single collection, or **Compare all selected items** if they are from multiple collections.
  - The profiles will be shown side-by-side similar to the Search Results page.
